Municipal Grants Applications for Gaming Revenue Are Now Available

Erie, PA - The Erie County Gaming Revenue Authority (ECGRA) announces that municipal grant applications for 2009 gaming revenues, as well as related documents, are available online at eriecountygov.org/ecgra. The application period runs from November 2, 2009 to December 16, 2009. **Mailed and hand-delivered applications should be submitted to The Erie County Gaming Revenue Authority, c/o the Gaming Revenue Manager, Erie County Court House, Room 503, Erie, Pennsylvania, 16501. The application postmark deadline date is December 16, 2009. Hand-delivered applications must be delivered to the office of the Gaming Revenue Manager by 4:00 p.m. on December 16, 2009. ECGRA is charged with the responsibility of administering Municipal Grants of 50% of gaming revenue received of the State Gaming Fund.

Grant applications are limited to the following municipalities: Summit, Millcreek, McKean, Waterford and Green Townships and the County of Erie. Municipal grants are used for funding of human services, infrastructure improvements, facilities, emergency services, health and public safety expenses associated with the operations of Presque Isle Downs and Casino.
