**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS/QUALIFICATIONS:**

High school diploma. Possession of a current Pennsylvania driver's license. Must have passed the obstacle course and basic adult education tests (current list). Must pass psychological evaluation and physical examination. Must be Act 2 certified within one year of hire. Act 120 and/or law enforcement or corrections experience preferred.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, & ABILITIES:**

Working knowledge of all laws, rules, regulations and procedures relating to the duties of the Sheriff's Department. Ability to deal with people under various circumstances. Must possess the operating knowledge of the x-ray and metal detector equipment. Must possess high moral standards, integrity, impartiality and good judgment in dealing with the general public.

**DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Prepare court transport list daily, Transport prisoners, perform thorough search of all prisoners, and account for all personal property. Provide security of the holding cells. Supervise the cleaning and maintenance of the facility. Maintain records, and legal documents of prisoners for transportation.

Provide physical security at all entrances of the Courthouse. This would require checking all employees, general public and packages before admittance to the Courthouse and provide perimeter security of the facility. Perform all other duties as may be required.

The above statements reflect the general details considered necessary to describe the principal functions of the job and shall not be considered a detailed description of all the work requirements that may be inherent in the job.

**DEFINITION OF CLASS:**

Transportation of prisoners from Erie County Prison to Erie County Sheriff holding facility. Secure and maintain order among prisoners. Prepare prisoners for court, process prisoners for transport, account for all personal property entering and leaving the holding area. Work courthouse and court security and assist Deputy Sheriffs in the performance of Deputy Sheriff duties.
